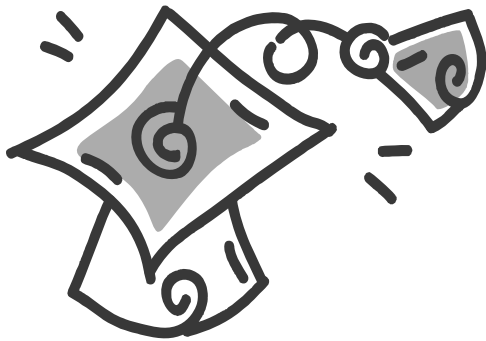

## Safe Grad - A Tradition That Makes A Difference



### It's time to register for Safe Grad!

Safe Grad has been a tradition for Carson High since 1988. The party begins the evening of June 6<sup>th</sup> after Graduation at the Carson City Community Center. Once inside the Community Center, Graduates will experience a variety of fun and safe activities including food, music, entertainment, swimming, games and other activities during the all-night party. After breakfast Graduates will load onto buses and head to Six Flags Marine World for an exciting day at the park.

All Grads must complete the Safe Grad 2009 Registration Form and Agreement to Obey Form

## How to Register

**Registration Period is from April 20th through May 1st.**

1. Complete the attached Safe Grad 2009 Registration Form and Agreement to Obey Form.
2. Include \$30 fee if Grad is going on Six Flags trip (checks payable to PTSA Safe Grad)

in order to attend the Safe Grad party and/or Six Flags Trip.

Grads are not to arrive at the Safe Grad Party impaired in any way. Grads are not allowed to leave Safe Grad once they have checked-in and will not be readmitted if they leave.

Check-In begins at 8:00 p.m. with doors closing at 9:00 p.m. Once Graduates have checked-in, we provide safe and secure storage for their bags, backpacks and other personal items. Grads will be allowed to access their bags as needed throughout the night. *(all bags will be searched by Carson City Sheriff's deputies at check-in)*

The buses bound for Six Flags will leave around 6:00 a.m. and return about midnight, Sunday June 7th. Participants must attend the Safe Grad Party to go on the Six Flags Trip.

### SAFE GRAD Cost:

- The Safe Grad Party is *free!*
- The cost for Six Flag Trip is \$30 per Graduate and includes transportation to and from and park and the park entrance fee.

Return forms and payment to the CHS Student Finance Office no later than Friday, May 1st.

*Grads under the age of 18 require a parent/guardian's signature to attend the party/trip.*

**Space for the Six Flags Trip is limited. Please register early!**

## Memory Wall Instructions

### Photo College Poster

Poster size: 11X17 - Paper is available at FedEx Kinko's

1. Place Grad's name somewhere on poster and if you would like, a special note to them
2. Add up to 15 pictures of your grad by mounting them on the poster (a few pieces of rolled tape works well)
3. Add captions or jazz up your poster by adding stickers, stamps, colored paper etc. Be as creative as you like!
4. Make a color copy your poster on 90lb white paper. FedEx Kinko's on Highway 50 (behind Starbucks) is able to do this for around \$4.00
5. Deliver your 90lb color copy to the CHS Attendance Office between May 11 and May 29.

*Note: we ask for a color copy on 90lb paper for easy and sturdy mounting of your poster on our wall. Also we don't have to worry about lost pictures that may fall off.*

Please do not laminate your poster.

Your poster will be available for pick up from the Attendance Office after June 8th.
